ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES AT LOK KING STREET, FO TAN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 23 June 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the western kerbside lane of Lok King Street from a point about 238 metres south of its junction with Lok Shun Path to a point about 275 metres south of the same junction;
- (b) the western kerbside lane of Lok King Street from a point about 15 metres north of its junction with the access road leading to The Palazzo to a point about 26 metres south of the same junction;
- (c) the western kerbside lane of Lok King Street from a point about 182 metres north of its junction with the unnamed road leading to Jockey Club Ti-I College to a point about 236 metres north of the same junction;
- (d) the eastern kerbside lane of Lok King Street from a point about 220 metres south of its junction with Lok Shun Path to a point about 256 metres south of the same junction;
- (e) the eastern kerbside lane of Lok King Street from a point about 64 metres north of its junction with the access road leading to The Palazzo to a point about 45 metres south of the same junction; and
- (f) the eastern kerbside lane of Lok King Street from its junction with the access road leading to Fo Tan Railway House to a point about 49 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
