

**RAILWAYS ORDINANCE (Chapter 519)
(Notice under section 23)**

RAILWAY STATION AT SIU HO WAN

**NOTICE OF ORDER AUTHORIZING
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF
SECTIONS OF SHUN LONG ROAD AND
NORTH LANTAU HIGHWAY ADJACENT TO THE SIU HO WAN DEPOT, AND
SECTIONS OF A SLIP ROAD FROM THE SIU HO WAN DEPOT TO
NORTH LANTAU HIGHWAY**

Notice is hereby given that under section 22(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), the Deputy Secretary for Transport and Logistics has, by order made on 29 May 2024 (the ‘Order’), authorized:–

- (I) the temporary closure of the section of Shun Long Road adjacent to the Siu Ho Wan Depot between a point about 85 metres northeast of its junction with North Lantau Highway and a point about 740 metres southwest of the junction, as delineated and shown in yellow on the Plans numbered SHO/G01/0001/3 and SHO/G02/0001/3;
- (II) the temporary closure of the section of North Lantau Highway adjacent to the Siu Ho Wan Depot between a point about 85 metres northeast of its junction with Shun Long Road and a point about 290 metres northeast of the junction, as delineated and shown in green on the Plan numbered SHO/G02/0001/3; and
- (III) the temporary closure of sections of the slip road from the Siu Ho Wan Depot to North Lantau Highway, as delineated and shown in orange on the Plan numbered SHO/G01/0001/3,

during the period from 1 July 2024 to 30 June 2025 for the purposes of or incidental to the railway scheme of the Railway Station at Siu Ho Wan. A description of the works to be carried out, the sections of the roads to be affected and the manner in which they will be affected is given in the Schedule below.

A copy of the Order and the Plans numbered SHO/G01/0001/3 and SHO/G02/0001/3 (the ‘Plans’) may be inspected by the public free of charge at the following places and during the following hours when those offices are normally open to the public:–

A copy of this notice will be affixed on or near the roads affected by the Order on 14 June 2024.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Logistics so as to reach the Secretary for Transport and Logistics before the expiration of one year from the closure of the relevant part or parts of the roads or the extinction, modification or restriction of his private right in respect of the relevant part or parts of the roads affected by the Order. Claims can be submitted via one of the following means:–

- (1) by post or by hand to the Transport and Logistics Bureau’s Drop-in Box No. 6 located at the 2nd Floor Entrance, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong. The box is available for use between 8:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. from Monday to Friday (except public holidays);

Notice is hereby given that further closure of the same part or parts of the roads or any of such part or parts may be required upon expiration of the Order. Details of any further order for closure will be published if and when such an order is made.

<i>The roads to be affected</i>	<i>Description of the works and the manner in which the roads will be affected</i>
(a) The section of Shun Long Road adjacent to the Siu Ho Wan Depot between a point about 85 metres northeast of its junction with North Lantau Highway and a point about 740 metres southwest of the junction, as delineated and shown in yellow on the Plans numbered SHO/G01/0001/3 and SHO/G02/0001/3.	Part of the carriageway widths will be temporarily closed to facilitate the construction works for the railway station at Siu Ho Wan and associated facilities.
(b) The section of North Lantau Highway adjacent to the Siu Ho Wan Depot between a point about 85 metres northeast of its junction with Shun Long Road and a point about 290 metres northeast of the junction, as delineated and shown in green on the Plan numbered SHO/G02/0001/3.	Part of the carriageway widths will be temporarily closed to facilitate the construction works for the railway station at Siu Ho Wan and associated facilities.
(c) Sections of the slip road from the Siu Ho Wan Depot to North Lantau Highway, as delineated and shown in orange on the Plan numbered SHO/G01/0001/3.	Part of the hard shoulders will be temporarily closed to facilitate the construction works for the railway station at Siu Ho Wan.

Any information, including the personal data, so submitted may be disclosed to the relevant government departments and other organizations or agencies which are required to handle the claims and related matters. Persons who have so submitted their personal data have the rights to request access to and correction of their personal data held by us.
