ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

## RESTRICTED ZONES ON ON YAN STREET AND ON SAU ROAD, KWUN TONG

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 21 June 2024, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the northern kerbside lane of On Yan Street from a point about 85 metres west of its southern junction with On Sau Road to a point about 75 metres west of the same junction;
- (b) the northern kerbside lane of On Yan Street from its southern junction with On Sau Road to a point about 30 metres west of the same junction;
- (c) the southern kerbside lane of On Yan Street from a point about 20 metres east of its junction with the unnamed access road near Yung Tai House to a point about 35 metres west of the same junction;
- (d) the southern kerbside lane of On Yan Street from its southern junction with On Sau Road to a point about 25 metres west of the same junction; and
- (e) the western kerbside lane of On Sau Road from a point about 35 metres south of its southern junction with On Yan Street to a point around 30 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
