

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN UN CHAU STREET AND PEI HO STREET,  
SHAM SHUI PO

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 20 June 2023, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the section of Un Chau Street from a point about 25 metres east of its junction with Pei Ho Street to a point about 30 metres west of the same junction;
- (b) the section of Pei Ho Street from its junction with Un Chau Street to a point about 5 metres south of the same junction;
- (c) the western kerbside lane of Pei Ho Street between Un Chau Street and Tai Po Road;
- (d) the eastern kerbside lane of Pei Ho Street from its junction with Un Chau Street to a point about 15 metres north of the same junction; and
- (e) the eastern kerbside lane of Pei Ho Street from its junction with Tai Po Road to a point about 10 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
