ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN TAI HANG

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 9.00 a.m. on 16 June 2023, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the northern kerbside lane of King Street from its junction with Wun Sha Street to a point about 3 metres west of the same junction;
- (b) the northern and southern kerbside lanes of Shepherd Street from its junction with Wun Sha Street to a point about 5 metres west of the same junction; and
- (c) the northern kerbside lane of Sun Chun Street from its junction with Wun Sha Street to a point about 5 metres west of the same junction.

Within the restricted zone, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.
