

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES  
IN HAI TAN STREET AND KWEILIN STREET, SHAM SHUI PO

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 6.00 p.m. on 28 June 2022 to 6.00 p.m. on 18 August 2022, the following road sections will continue to be temporarily designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the section of Kweilin Street from a point about 10 metres south of its junction with Hai Tan Street to a point about 10 metres north of the same junction; and
- (b) the section of Hai Tan Street from a point about 35 metres east of its junction with Kweilin Street to a point about 25 metres west of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be temporarily rescinded.
