

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

PROHIBITED ZONES FOR VEHICLES EXCEEDING 7 METRES IN LENGTH AT
VEHICULAR BRIDGES CONNECTING KAM POK ROAD AND YAU POK ROAD,
YUEN LONG

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 21 June 2024, the two unnamed vehicular bridges connecting Kam Pok Road and Yau Pok Road will be designated as prohibited zone for vehicles exceeding 7 metres in length 24 hours daily (except for access).

Drivers of all motor vehicles, except those for access and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from driving any motor vehicles exceeding 7 metres in length into the prohibited zone.

The extent of the prohibited zone will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs.

At the same time, the existing prohibited zones for vehicle exceeding 7 metres in length on the above road sections will be rescinded.
