Explanatory Note

This Regulation amends the Merchant Shipping (Safety) (Life-Saving Appliances and Arrangements, Musters and Training) Regulation (Cap. 369 sub. leg. AY) (*principal Regulation*).

- 2. The Maritime Safety Committee of the International Maritime Organization passed resolution MSC.496(105) on 28 April 2022. The purpose of this Regulation is to deal with the amendments, adopted by the resolution, to Chapter III of the Annex to the International Convention for the Safety of Life at Sea, 1974 (*Chapter III*).
- 3. After the amendments to Chapter III, the requirements relating to radio life-saving appliances will no longer be contained in Chapter III. As a result, section 4(6) of the principal Regulation will become obsolete. This Regulation therefore repeals that section and consequentially amends section 3(2)(e) of the principal Regulation.
