

ROAD TRAFFIC (PUBLIC SERVICE VEHICLES) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374D)

PACKAGES OF PUBLIC LIGHT BUS (SCHEDULED) ROUTES IN
THE NEW TERRITORIES

In accordance with regulation 4(2) of the Road Traffic (Public Service Vehicles) Regulations (Chapter 374D), applications are hereby invited for the issue of passenger service licences for the operation of the following packages of public light bus (scheduled) routes in the New Territories (Please see the particulars below).

Applications must be made by way of the appropriate application form ('Application for Passenger Service Licence(s) in Respect of the Packages of Public Light Bus (Scheduled) Routes Gazetted in June 2023') obtainable, free of charge, on request from the following offices as from 30 June 2023:—

- (a) the Transport Department New Territories Regional Office, 7th Floor, Mongkok Government Offices, 30 Luen Wan Street, Kowloon;
- (b) the Transport Department Public Light Bus Section, 11th Floor, South Tower, West Kowloon Government Offices, 11 Hoi Ting Road, Yau Ma Tei, Kowloon;
- (c) the Transport Department Urban Regional Office (Hong Kong), 37th Floor, Immigration Tower, 7 Gloucester Road, Hong Kong; and
- (d) the Transport Department Hong Kong Licensing Office, 3rd Floor, United Centre, 95 Queensway, Hong Kong.

Completed application forms and supporting documents (one (1) original and seven (7) legible photocopies) must be submitted in a plain white envelope sealed and marked on the outside of the envelope with 'Application for Passenger Service Licence(s) in Respect of the Packages of Public Light Bus (Scheduled) Routes Gazetted in June 2023' and placed in the Transport Department Tender Box situated at the reception counter of the Transport Department Headquarters on the 10th Floor of South Tower, West Kowloon Government Offices, 11 Hoi Ting Road, Yau Ma Tei, Kowloon before 12.00 noon on 25 August 2023 (Friday). If a black rainstorm warning signal or tropical cyclone warning signal no. 8 or above is in force between 9.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon on 25 August 2023, the application closing time will be postponed to 12.00 noon on the next working day. Applications made by other means or submitted late will not be considered.

The Government reserves the right to modify the routes and details of operation contained in this notice and does not bind itself to accept any such application received.
