

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES IN SHUN YUNG STREET AND
PAK KUNG STREET, HUNG HOM

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 8.00 a.m. on 3 July 2023 to 6.00 p.m. on 24 July 2023, the following road sections will be temporarily designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the western kerbside lane of Shun Yung Street from a point about 105 metres north of its junction with Fat Kwong Street to a point about 215 metres north of the same junction;
- (b) the eastern kerbside lane of Shun Yung Street from its junction with Pak Kung Street to a point about 70 metres south of the same junction; and
- (c) the southern kerbside lane of Pak Kung Street from its junction with Shun Yung Street to a point about 15 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be temporarily rescinded.
