ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN TAI PO

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 30 June 2023, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the section of the unnamed access road leading to Ng Tung Chai from its junction with the roundabout on Lam Kam Road near Ng Tung Chai to a point about 10 metres south of the same junction:
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of the roundabout on Lam Kam Road near Ng Tung Chai from a point about 10 metres west of its junction with the unnamed access road leading to Ng Tung Chai to a point about 15 metres east of the same junction;
- (c) the southern kerbside lane of the westbound carriageway of Lam Kam Road from its junction with the roundabout on Lam Kam Road near Ng Tung Chai to a point about 20 metres west of the same junction;
- (d) the southern kerbside lane of the westbound carriageway of Lam Kam Road from a point about 5 metres east of its junction with the roundabout on Lam Kam Road near Ng Tung Chai to a point about 40 metres east of the same junction; and
- (e) the northern kerbside lane of the eastbound carriageway of Lam Kam Road from a point about 5 metres east of its junction with the roundabout on Lam Kam Road near Ng Tung Chai to a point about 30 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.
