ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES IN KING LAM STREET AND TAI NAN WEST STREET, LAI CHI KOK

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 11.59 p.m. on 9 July 2022 to 11.59 p.m. on 23 September 2022, the following road sections will continue to be temporarily designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the section of King Lam Street from its junction with Tai Nan West Street to a point about 135 metres west of the same junction; and
- (b) the western kerbside lane of Tai Nan West Street from its junction with King Lam Street to a point about 10 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will continue to be temporarily rescinded.
