ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONE ON BORRETT ROAD

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 9 July 2022, the western kerbside lane of Borrett Road from a point about 140 metres south of its junction with Bowen Road to a point about 235 metres south of the same junction will be designated as a restricted zone 24 hours daily.

Within the restricted zone, drivers of motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zone will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs or road markings. At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road section will be rescinded.
