

PHARMACY AND POISONS ORDINANCE (Chapter 138)

DIRECTION MADE BY THE DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE  
OF THE PHARMACY AND POISONS BOARD OF HONG KONG

It is hereby notified that a Disciplinary Committee appointed by the Pharmacy and Poisons Board of Hong Kong under section 15 of the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance (Chapter 138, Laws of Hong Kong) to inquire into matters touching on professional misconduct of Ms. TSOI Chun-wai, Truda, a registered pharmacist, has conducted an inquiry on 31 May 2022 in accordance with section 16 of the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance.

The said Committee was satisfied after the inquiry that Ms. TSOI Chun-wai, Truda, a registered pharmacist, had been guilty of misconduct in that she was convicted of the following offence under the Antibiotics Ordinance (Chapter 137, Laws of Hong Kong) on 8 November 2021 at Fanling Magistrates' Courts for which the following order was imposed:—

The said Committee was satisfied that Ms. TSOI Chun-wai, Truda had failed to comply with the relevant part of section 2.2.5 of the Code of Professional Conduct for the Guidance of Registered Pharmacists in Hong Kong which requires a registered pharmacist to comply with the laws that govern practice relating to his/her professional duties.

It is further notified that under section 16(2)(a) of the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance, the said Committee directed the Secretary of the Pharmacy and Poisons Board of Hong Kong to censure Ms. TSOI Chun-wai, Truda. The said Committee added that its direction should be published in the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region *Gazette* with an account of the proceedings.
