ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

## RESTRICTED ZONES ON LOK SHAN ROAD, TO KWA WAN ROAD AND CHEUNG NING STREET. TO KWA WAN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 15 July 2022, the following road sections in To Kwa Wan will be designated as restricted zones at the time specified below:—

24 hours daily

- (a) the section of Lok Shan Road from its junction with To Kwa Wan Road to a point about 50 metres west of the same junction;
- (b) the western kerbside lane of To Kwa Wan Road from its junction with Lok Shan Road to a point about 5 metres north of the same junction;
- (c) the western kerbside lane of To Kwa Wan Road from its junction with Lok Shan Road to a point about 10 metres south of the same junction; and
- (d) the section of Cheung Ning Street from its junction with Lok Shan Road to a point about 15 metres north of the same junction.

From 7.00 a.m. to 7.00 p.m. daily

(a) the southern kerbside lane of Lok Shan Road from its junction with Ha Heung Road to a point about 35 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
