NURSES REGISTRATION ORDINANCE (Chapter 164)

ORDER MADE BY THE NURSING COUNCIL OF HONG KONG

It is hereby notified that the Nursing Council of Hong Kong, after due inquiry held on 3 November 2021 and 30 May 2022 in accordance with section 17 of the Nurses Registration Ordinance, Chapter 164 of the Laws of Hong Kong, was satisfied that Ms. YEUNG Yu-ting Hazel, being a registered nurse (Registration No. RNG0006733), was convicted on 21 June 2012 and 11 March 2013 at the Eastern Magistrates' Courts of two counts of the offence of 'theft', which is an offence punishable with imprisonment, contrary to section 9 of the Theft Ordinance, Chapter 210, Laws of Hong Kong, and she declared in the application for registration as a registered nurse on 22 November 2018 that she had not been convicted of any offence punishable with imprisonment in Hong Kong or elsewhere, and thereby obtaining her registration by fraud or misrepresentation, contrary to section 17(1)(c) of the Nurses Registration Ordinance, Chapter 164, Laws of Hong Kong.

In accordance with section 17 of the Nurses Registration Ordinance, the Council ordered on 30 May 2022 that Ms. YEUNG Yu-ting Hazel be reprimanded, and that such decision be published in the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Gazette with an account of the proceedings.
