ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON TUEN MUN HEUNG SZE WUI ROAD AND YAN CHING STREET, TUEN MUN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 21 January 2022, the following road sections in Tuen Mun will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the western kerbside lane of Tuen Mun Heung Sze Wui Road from a point about 10 metres south of its junction with Yan Ching Street to a point about 30 metres south of the same junction;
- (b) the western kerbside lane of Tuen Mun Heung Sze Wui Road from a point about 10 metres north of its junction with Yan Ching Street to a point about 35 metres north of the same junction;
- (c) the eastern kerbside lane of Tuen Mun Heung Sze Wui Road from its junction with Yan Ching Street to a point about 25 metres south of the same junction; and
- (d) the southern kerbside lane of Yan Ching Street from its junction with Tuen Mun Heung Sze Wui Road to a point about 15 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
