ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN TAI YAU STREET, SAM CHUK STREET AND TSEUK LUK STREET. SAN PO KONG

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 24 January 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the eastern kerbside lane of Tai Yau Street from its junction with Tseuk Luk Street to a point about 110 metres north of the same junction;
- (b) the section of Sam Chuk Street from its junction with Tai Yau Street to a point about 10 metres east of the same junction; and
- (c) the northern kerbside lane of Tseuk Luk Street from its junction with Tai Yau Street to a point about 15 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
