## ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

## RESTRICTED ZONES IN FO TAN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 21 January 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the western kerbside lane of Tsung Tau Ha Road from a point about 20 metres north of its junction with Au Pui Wan Street to a point about 35 metres south of the same junction;
- (b) the western kerbside lane of Tsung Tau Ha Road from its junction with Kwei Tei Street to a point about 20 metres north of the same junction;
- (c) the eastern kerbside lane of Tsung Tau Ha Road from a point about 28 metres north of its junction with Kwei Tei Street to a point about 58 metres north of the same junction;
- (d) the section of Au Pui Wan Street from its junction with Tsung Tau Ha Road to a point about 10 metres west of the same junction;
- (e) the northern kerbside lane of Kwei Tei Street from its junction with Tsung Tau Ha Road to a point about 46 metres west of the same junction; and
- (f) the southern kerbside lane of Kwei Tei Street from its junction with Tsung Tau Ha Road to a point about 30 metres west of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
