ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON TUNG LO WAN ROAD AND WARREN STREET, TAI HANG

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 24 January 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the southern kerbside lane of Tung Lo Wan Road from its junction with Warren Street to a point about 10 metres west of the same junction;
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of Tung Lo Wan Road from its junction with Warren Street to a point about 5 metres east of the same junction;
- (c) the eastern kerbside lane of Warren Street from its junction with Tung Lo Wan Road to a point about 5 metres south of the same junction; and
- (d) the western kerbside lane of Warren Street from its junction with Tung Lo Wan Road to a point about 5 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zone, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner of Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.
