

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON KAI KING ROAD AND  
YAN KING ROAD, TSEUNG KWAN O

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation (14)(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 21 January 2022, the following road sections in Tseung Kwan O will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the northern kerbside lane of Kai King Road from a point about 56 metres west from its junction with Yan King Road to western kerbside lane of a point about 20 metres north of the same junction; and
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of Kai King Road from a point about 19 metres west from its junction with Yan King Road to a point about 50 metres west of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
