ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON PUI SHING ROAD AND MAN KUK LANE. TSEUNG KWAN O

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation (14)(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 21 January 2022, the following road sections in Tseung Kwan O will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the southern kerbside lane of Pui Shing Road from a point about 23 metres east from its junction with Man Kuk Lane to eastern kerbside lane of a point about 54 metres south of the same junction; and
- (b) the western kerbside lane of Man Kuk Lane from a point about 70 metres south from its junction with Pui Shing Road to a point about 30 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
