

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374 sub. leg. G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON MA SIK ROAD AND WO TAI STREET,
NORTH DISTRICT

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374 sub. leg. G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 6 August 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the northern kerbside lane of Ma Sik Road from a point about 30 metres west of its junction with Wo Tai Street to a point about 30 metres east of the same junction;
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of Ma Sik Road from its junction with Wo Tai Street to a point about 22 metres west of the same junction;
- (c) the western kerbside lane of Wo Tai Street from its junction with Ma Sik Road to a point about 25 metres south of the same junction;
- (d) the southern kerbside lane of Ma Sik Road from its junction with Wo Tai Street to a point about 22 metres east of the same junction; and
- (e) the eastern kerbside lane of Wo Tai Street from its junction with Ma Sik Road to a point about 15 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road section will be rescinded.
