ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374 Sub. Leg. G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON LUEN CHIT STREET AND WO MUK ROAD, NORTH DISTRICT

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374 sub. leg. G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 4 August 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the eastern kerbside lane of Luen Chit Street from its junction with Wo Muk Road to a point about 30 metres north of the same junction;
- (b) the northern kerbside lane of Wo Muk Road from its junction with Luen Chit Street to a point about 8 metres east of the same junction;
- (c) the western kerbside lane of Luen Chit Street from its junction with Wo Muk Road to a point about 35 metres north of the same junction;
- (d) the northern kerbside lane of Wo Muk Road from its junction with Luen Chit Street to a point about 54 metres west of the same junction; and
- (e) the southern kerbside lane of Wo Muk Road from a point about 20 metres west of its junction with Luen Chit Street to a point about 44 metres west of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road section will be rescinded.
