

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES ON
BATTERY STREET, YAU MA TEI

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 1 August 2022 to 31 October 2022, the following road sections will continue to be temporarily designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the eastern kerbside lane of Battery Street from its junction with Kansu Street to a point about 50 metres south of the same junction (except metered parking spaces); and
- (b) the western kerbside lane of Battery Street from its junction with Kansu Street to a point about 20 metres south of the same junction (except metered parking spaces).

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones have been indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will continue to be temporarily rescinded.
