ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374 sub. leg. G)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN TIN HAU

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374 sub. leg. G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 29 July 2022, the following road sections in Tin Hau will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the southern kerbside lane of King's Road from its junction with Lau Sin Street to a point about 30 metres east of the same junction;
- (b) the northern kerbside lane of Lau Sin Street from its junction with King's Road to a point about 15 metres east of the same junction;
- (c) the southern kerbside lane of King's Road from its junction with Lau Sin Street to a point about 10 metres west of the same junction; and
- (d) the southern kerbside lane of Lau Sin Street from its junction with King's Road to a point about 5 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
