

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON PO LOK SQUARE, PING SHUN STREET AND
YUEN LONG ON NING ROAD, YUEN LONG

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 29 July 2022:—

- (a) the section of Po Lok Square from its junction with Ping Shun Street to a point about 10 metres east of the same junction;
- (b) the eastern kerbside lane of Ping Shun Street from its junction with Po Lok Square to a point about 15 metres north of the same junction;
- (c) the eastern kerbside lane of Ping Shun Street from a point about 10 metres north of its junction with Yuen Long On Ning Road to a point about 25 metres north of the same junction;
- (d) the northern kerbside lane of Yuen Long On Ning Road from a point about 10 metres west of its junction with Ping Shun Street to a point about 30 metres west of the same junction; and
- (e) the southern kerbside lane of Yuen Long On Ning Road from a point about 5 metres east of its junction with Ping Shun Street to a point about 15 metres west of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
