ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON CHEUNG MOU STREET AND CHEUNG YEE STREET LAI CHI KOK

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 9 August 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the western kerbside lane of Cheung Mou Street from its junction with Cheung Shun Street to a point about 60 metres south of the same junction;
- (b) the western kerbside lane of Cheung Mou Street from a point about 5 metres south of its junction with Cheung Yee Street to a point about 25 metres south of the same junction;
- (c) the eastern kerbside lane of Cheung Mou Street from its junction with Cheung Shun Street to a point about 85 metres south of the same junction; and
- (d) the section of Cheung Yee Street from its junction with Cheung Mou Street to a point about 25 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road section will be rescinded.
