CHINESE MEDICINE ORDINANCE (Chapter 549)

ORDER MADE BY THE CHINESE MEDICINE PRACTITIONERS BOARD OF THE CHINESE MEDICINE COUNCIL OF HONG KONG

Notice is hereby given that the Chinese Medicine Practitioners Board of the Chinese Medicine Council of Hong Kong, after inquiry on 19 June 2023 conducted pursuant to section 98(2) of the Chinese Medicine Ordinance (Chapter 549, Laws of Hong Kong), was satisfied that the following charges of professional misconduct against CHAN Kin-hung, registered Chinese medicine practitioner (Registration No.: 000001), are proved:—

- (1) he was convicted at the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Tuen Mun Magistrates' Courts on 28 November 2022 of an offence, namely, 'possession of unregistered proprietary Chinese medicine', contrary to sections 119(1)(c) and 155(1) of the Chinese Medicine Ordinance, and hence breached section 98(2)(a) of the Chinese Medicine Ordinance for having been convicted in Hong Kong of an offence punishable with imprisonment; and
- (2) failing to report to the Chinese Medicine Practitioners Board within 28 days after being convicted of the offence punishable with imprisonment stated in (1) above, contrary to section 1(2) of Part 3 of the Code of Professional Conduct for Registered Chinese Medicine Practitioners in Hong Kong, and hence was found guilty in Hong Kong or elsewhere of misconduct in a professional respect and in breach of the conditions imposed by the Chinese Medicine Practitioners Board on his practice of Chinese medicine under section 98(2)(b) and 98(2)(e) of the Chinese Medicine Ordinance respectively.

Pursuant to section 98(3) of the Chinese Medicine Ordinance, the Chinese Medicine Practitioners Board ordered on 19 June 2023 that, for the above established charges, CHAN Kin-hung be reprimanded.

In accordance with section 104 of the Chinese Medicine Ordinance, the above order made by the Chinese Medicine Practitioners Board of the Chinese Medicine Council of Hong Kong is hereby published.
