ESTATE AGENTS ORDINANCE (Chapter 511)

Pursuant to section 30 of the Estate Agents Ordinance, it is hereby notified that the Disciplinary Committee of Estate Agents Authority has exercised the following disciplinary power against the following licensee:—

<i>Matter Concerned</i>	The licensee, in handling the sale and purchase transaction of a property, failed to keep the original or a copy of the documents, and a record of the data and information obtained in the course of identifying and verifying the identity of the customer.
<i>Date of Decision</i>	28 June 2022
<i>Decision on Disciplinary Power Exercised</i>	(a) Reprimand; and (b) The following condition be attached to the licence concerned of the licensee:— ‘The above-named licensee shall, during the period of 12 months from 18 July 2022 to 17 July 2023, attend and complete activities under the Estate Agents Authority Continuing Professional Development Scheme ‘Compliance and Effective Management’ category by way of seminars or lectures only and thereby acquire 12 points recognised by the Estate Agents Authority, and at least 6 points of which shall be acquired from seminars or lectures on the Estate Agents Ordinance and its subsidiary legislation, Code of Ethics and Practice Circulars subject.’
