ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE (Chapter 374)

TEMPORARY SPEED LIMIT ON WEST KOWLOON HIGHWAY

In exercise of the powers vested in me under section 40(2)(a) of the Road Traffic Ordinance, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that from 1.00 a.m. to 5.30 a.m. daily on Mondays to Saturdays during the period from 17 August 2022 to 6 September 2022, the following sections of West Kowloon Highway will be temporarily subject to a speed limit of 70 kilometres per hour:—

- (a) the section of West Kowloon Highway northbound from a point about 90 metres south of Hoi Fai Road roundabout to a point about 75 metres south of the junction between Lin Cheung Road and Tonkin Street West; and
- (b) the section of West Kowloon Highway southbound from a point about 150 metres north of its junction with the slip road from Tsing Sha Highway to a point about 160 metres south of the junction between Lin Cheung Road and Tonkin Street West.

Appropriate traffic signs will be erected on site to guide motorists.

At the same time, the existing speed limit of 100 kilometres per hour on the above road sections will be temporarily rescinded.
