ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON ON MING STREET AND ON MUK STREET AT SHEK MUN. SHA TIN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 12 August 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the western kerbside lane of On Ming Street northbound from a point about 45 metres south of its junction with On Muk Street to a point about 25 metres north of the same junction;
- (b) the eastern kerbside lane of On Ming Street southbound from a point about 30 metres north of its junction with On Muk Street to the same junction; and
- (c) the section of On Muk Street from a point about 45 metres west of its junction with On Ming Street to a point about 30 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
