ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON TUNG CHAU WEST STREET AND KING LAM STREET. LAI CHI KOK

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 12 August 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the nearside lane of Tung Chau West Street between Wing Hong Street and King Lam Street;
- (b) the eastern kerbside lane of Tung Chau West Street from its junction with King Lam Street to a point about 20 metres south of the same junction; and
- (c) the southern kerbside carriageway of King Lam Street from a point about 20 metres east of its junction with Tung Chau West Street to a point about 20 metres west of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road section will be rescinded.
