

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES IN KOK CHEUNG STREET  
AND FUK CHAK STREET, TAI KOK TSUI

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulation, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 6.00 p.m. on 20 August 2022 to 6.00 p.m. on 20 October 2022, the following road sections will continue to be temporarily designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the eastern kerbside lane of Kok Cheung Street from its junction with Li Tak Street to a point about 85 metres south of the same junction;
- (b) the western kerbside lane of Kok Cheung Street from its junction with Li Tak Street to a point about 85 metres south of the same junction; and
- (c) the section of Fuk Chak Street from its junction with Kok Cheung Street to a point about 25 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones have been indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zone on the above road sections will continue to be temporarily rescinded.
