## ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

## RESTRICTED ZONE IN YUEN LONG

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 19 August 2022, the following sections of Tin Wu Road and Tin Yiu Road will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily as follows:—

- (a) the northern kerbside lane of Tin Wu Road from its junction with Tin Yiu Road to a point about 40 metres east of the same junction;
- (b) the northern kerbside lane of Tin Wu Road from its junction with Tin Yiu Road to a point about 25 metres west of the same junction;
- (c) the southern kerbside lane of Tin Wu Road from its junction with Tin Yiu Road to a point about 10 metres west of the same junction;
- (d) the western kerbside lane of Tin Yiu Road from its junction with Tin Wu Road to a point about 60 metres south of the same junction;
- (e) the southern kerbside lane of Tin Wu Road from its junction with Tin Yiu Road to a point about 30 metres east of the same junction; and
- (f) the eastern kerbside lane of Tin Yiu Road from its junction with Tin Wu Road to a point about 55 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zone, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zone will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
