

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON LAM CHAK STREET AND
KAI HING ROAD, KOWLOON BAY

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 6.00 a.m. on 28 August 2022, the following road sections in Kowloon Bay will be designated as restricted zones:—

From 7.00 a.m. to 7.00 p.m. daily (except General Holidays)

- (a) the section of Kai Hing Road from a point about 10 metres south of its southern junction with Hoi Bun Road to a point about 60 metres south of the same junction;

24 hours daily

- (b) the eastern kerbside lane of Kai Hing Road from a point about 20 metres east of its junction with Lam Chak Street to a point about 20 metres west of the same junction;
- (c) the western kerbside lane of Kai Hing Road from its junction with Lam Chak Street to a point of about 20 metres north of the same junction;
- (d) the western kerbside lane of Lam Chak Street from its junction with Kai Hing Road to a point of about 15 metres south of the same junction; and
- (e) the western kerbside lane of Lam Chak Street from its junction with Cheung Yip Street to its junction with Kai Hing Road.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones have been indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
