ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON KI LUNG STREET AND MAPLE STREET, SHAM SHUI PO

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 30 August 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the southern carriageway of Ki Lung Street from its junction with Maple Street to a point about 6 metres west of the same junction;
- (b) the northern carriageway of Ki Lung Street from a point about 8 metres west of its junction with Maple Street to a point about 8 metres east of the same junction; and
- (c) the western kerbside lane of Maple Street from a point about 10 metres south of its junction with Ki Lung Street to a point about 10 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
