

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN KIN WAN STREET, HUNG HOM

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 7.00 a.m. on 1 September 2022, the following road sections in Kin Wan Street will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the eastern kerbside lane of Kin Wan Street from a point about 60 metres south of its junction with Hung Luen Road to a point about 165 metres south of the same junction; and
- (b) the western kerbside lane of Kin Wan Street from a point about 65 metres south of its junction with Hung Luen Road to a point about 160 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
