

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN FO TAN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 26 August 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the northern kerbside lane of Fo Tan Road from a point about 50 metres west of its junction with Sui Wo Road to a point about 7 metres east of the same junction;
- (b) the northern kerbside lane of Fo Tan Road from a point about 36 metres west of its junction with Tsung Tau Ha Road to a point about 37 metres east of the same junction;
- (c) the eastern kerbside lane of Fo Tan Road from a point about 36 metres north of its junction with Yuen Wo Road to a point about 27 metres south of the same junction;
- (d) the southern kerbside lane of Fo Tan Road with Sui Wo Road to a point about 24 metres south of the same junction;
- (e) the southern kerbside lane of Fo Tan Road from its junction with Tsung Tau Ha Road to a point about 33 metres south of the same junction;
- (f) the section of Sui Wo Road from its junction with Fo Tan Road to a point about 10 metres north of the same junction;
- (g) the section of Tsung Tau Ha Road from its junction with Fo Tan Road to a point about 7 metres north of the same junction; and
- (h) the section of Yuen Wo Road from its junction from Fo Tan Road to a point about 17 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
