

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON WAN CHAI ROAD AND TAI WO STREET,
WAN CHAI

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 26 August 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zone 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the eastern kerbside lane of Wan Chai Road from a point about 20 metres north of its junction with Cross Street to a point about 20 metres south of the same junction;
- (b) the western kerbside lane of Wan Chai Road from its junction with Cross Street to a point about 35 metres south of the same junction;
- (c) the section of Cross Street from its junction with Wan Chai Road to a point about 5 metres west of the same junction;
- (d) the western kerbside lane of Tai Wo Street from its junction with Wan Chai Road to a point about 20 metres north of the same junction;
- (e) the eastern kerbside lane of Tai Wo Street from its junction with Wan Chai Road to a point about 15 metres north of the same junction; and
- (f) the western kerbside lane of Wan Chai Road from its junction with Tai Wo Street to a point about 10 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zone, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
