

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONE IN KIN TAI STREET,
TUEN MUN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 6.00 p.m. on 28 August 2023 to 6.00 p.m. on 29 September 2023, the following road sections will continue to be temporarily designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the western kerbside lane of Kin Tai Street northbound from a point about 15 metres north of its junction with Kin Wing Street eastbound to a point about 70 metres north of the same junction; and
- (b) the eastern kerbside lane of Kin Tai Street southbound from a point about 20 metres north of its junction with Kin Wing Street eastbound to a point about 70 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
