

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374 sub. leg. G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON SHA TAU KOK ROAD—LUNG YEUK TAU AND
THE UNNAMED ACCESS ROAD LEADING TO THE SISTERS OF
THE PRECIOUS BLOOD, NORTH DISTRICT

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374 sub. leg. G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 28 August 2023, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the northern kerbside lane of Sha Tau Kok Road—Lung Yeuk Tau from a point about 24 metres south of its junction with the unnamed access road leading to the Sisters of the Precious Blood to a point about 18 metres north of the same junction; and
- (b) the section of the unnamed access road leading to the Sisters of the Precious Blood from its junction with Sha Tau Kok Road—Lung Yeuk Tau northbound to a point about 10 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.
