ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374 sub. leg. G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON TIN PING ROAD AND THE UNNAMED ACCESS ROAD BETWEEN SHEK WU HUI PUBLIC SCHOOL AND TIN PING ESTATE, SHEUNG SHUI

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374 sub. leg. G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 2 September 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the northern kerbside lane of Tin Ping Road from a point about 5 metres west of Lamp Post No. EA1536 to a point about 15 metres east of the same Lamp Post;
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of Tin Ping Road from a point about 10 metres west of Lamp Post No. EA1537 to a point about 50 metres west of the same Lamp Post; and
- (c) the section of the unnamed access road between Shek Wu Hui Public School and Tin Ping Estate from its junction with Tin Ping Road to a point about 10 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones from 8.00 a.m. to 10.00 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. to 7.00 p.m. daily on part of the above road sections will be rescinded.
