ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES ON QUEEN'S ROAD WEST, WESTERN DISTRICT

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 6.00 a.m. on 1 September 2023 to 6.00 p.m. on 30 September 2023, the following road sections will continue to be temporarily designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the southern kerbside lane of Queen's Road West from a point about 30 metres east of its junction with Hill Road to a point about 70 metres east of the same junction;
- (b) the northern kerbside lane of Queen's Road West from its junction with Hill Road to a point about 90 metres east of the same junction; and
- (c) the southern kerbside lane of Queen's Road West from a point about 35 metres west of its junction with Hill Road to a point about 65 metres west of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.
