ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON SIU LEK YUEN ROAD AND NGAN SHING STREET, SHA TIN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 9 September 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the northern kerbside lane of Siu Lek Yuen Road from a point about 13 metres west of its junction with Po Shing Street to a point about 23 metres east of the same junction;
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of Siu Lek Yuen Road from its junction with Po Shing Street to a point about 40 metres east of the same junction;
- (c) the northern kerbside lane of Siu Lek Yuen Road from its junction with Ngan Shing Street to a point about 48 metres west of the same junction;
- (d) the southern kerbside lane of Siu Lek Yuen Road from a point about 22 metres west of its junction with Ngan Shing Street to a point about 46 metres east of the same junction;
- (e) the western kerbside lane of Ngan Shing Street from its junction with Siu Lek Yuen Road to a point about 30 metres south of the same junction; and
- (f) the eastern kerbside lane of Ngan Shing Street from its junction with Siu Lek Yuen Road to a point about 14 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
