## ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

## RESTRICTED ZONES ON KWUN CHUI ROAD, TUEN MUN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 16 September 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the northern kerbside lane of Kwun Chui Road from a point about 220 metres west of its eastern junction with So Kwun Wat Road to a point about 250 metres west of the same junction;
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of Kwun Chui Road from a point about 220 metres west of its eastern junction with So Kwun Wat Road to a point about 255 metres west of the same junction;
- (c) the eastern kerbside lane of Kwun Chui Road from a point about 215 metres south of its northern junction with So Kwun Wat Road to a point about 245 metres south of the same junction;
- (d) the eastern kerbside lane of Kwun Chui Road from a point about 250 metres south of its northern junction with So Kwun Wat Road to a point about 265 metres south of the same junction; and
- (e) the western kerbside lane of Kwun Chui Road from a point about 215 metres south of its northern junction with So Kwun Wat Road to a point about 265 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.
