

## FORESHORE AND SEA-BED (RECLAMATIONS) ORDINANCE (Chapter 127)

(Notice of authorization under section 9)

PROPOSED INSTALLATION OF SUBMARINE CABLES  
FROM CHEUNG SHA TO AN ARTIFICIAL ISLAND NEAR SHEK KWU CHAU

It is hereby notified that the undertaking in relation to the foreshore and sea-bed described in the Schedule below was authorized under section 8(1)(c) by the Chief Executive in Council on 6 September 2022.

Any person who considers that he has an interest, right or easement in or over such foreshore and sea-bed that will be injuriously affected by the undertaking may deliver a written claim for compensation for the injurious affection to the Director of Lands, 20th Floor, North Point Government Offices, 333 Java Road, North Point, Hong Kong before the expiration of 1 year from the date of publication of this notice in the *Gazette*, stating the sum of money which he is willing to accept in full and final settlement of his claim together with such particulars as he may possess to substantiate the claim.

## SCHEDULE

*Foreshore and sea-bed affected*

Approximately 7 318 square metres of foreshore and sea-bed from Cheung Sha, Lantau Island to an artificial island near Shek Kwu Chau as delineated and shown by bold red lines on a plan, numbered ISM3198 deposited in the Land Registry.

*Description of the undertaking and the manner in which the foreshore and sea-bed will be affected by the proposed undertaking*

Two pairs of submarine cables (each consisting of a 132kV power cable and a fibre optic cable) will be laid from Upper Cheung Sha Beach to an artificial island near Shek Kwu Chau to support the operation of the Integrated Waste Management Facilities on the island. Each cable will be approximately 7 kilometres in length and no more than 200 millimetres in diameter. The major parts of the submarine cables will be laid by water-jet method while the shore-end part will be buried with hand-held jet.

Personal Information Collection Statement

Any information, including the personal data, submitted to the Director of Lands in connection with any written claims served under section 12(1) of the Foreshore and Sea-bed (Reclamations) Ordinance (Chapter 127) will be used for the processing of the claims and other related purposes. The provision of the information, including the personal data, as required under section 12(1) of the Foreshore and Sea-bed (Reclamations) Ordinance (Chapter 127) is obligatory. If such information, including the personal data, as required under section 12(1) of the Foreshore and Sea-bed (Reclamations) Ordinance (Chapter 127) is not provided as requested, the claims may be rejected. Any information, including the personal data, so submitted may be disclosed to the relevant government departments and other organizations or agencies which are required to handle the claims and related matters. Persons who have so submitted their personal data have the rights to request access to and correction of their personal data held by us. Request for access to or correction of the personal data should be made in writing to the Departmental Personal Data Controlling Officer of Lands Department at 21st Floor, North Point Government Offices, 333 Java Road, North Point, Hong Kong.
