

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES IN YIN HING STREET, SAN PO KONG

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulations 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 26 September 2022 to 6.00 p.m. on 30 November 2022, the following road sections in San Po Kong will be temporarily designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the section of Yin Hing Street from its junction with Foo Yuen Street to a point about 47 metres south of the same junction; and
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of Foo Yuen Street from its junction with Yin Hing Street to a point about 15 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be temporarily rescinded.
