## ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374G)

## RESTRICTED ZONES IN MA ON SHAN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 23 September 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the western kerbside lane of Ma On Shan Road northbound from a point about 20 metres south of its junction with On Shan Lane to a point about 20 metres north of the same junction;
- (b) the eastern kerbside lane of Ma On Shan Road southbound from a point about 50 metres north of its junction with On Shan Lane to a point about 20 metres south of the same junction;
- (c) the northern kerbside lane of On Shan Lane eastbound from its junction with Ma On Shan Road to a point about 20 metres east of the same junction; and
- (d) the southern kerbside lane of On Shan Lane westbound from a point about 45 metres east of its junction with Ma On Shan Road to the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
