ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374 sub. leg. G)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON LUEN ON STREET AND WO MUN STREET, FANLING

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374 sub. leg. G, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 p.m. on 27 September 2022, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the northern kerbside lane of Luen On Street from a point about 23 metres west of its junction with Wo Mun Street to a point about 5 metres north of the same junction;
- (b) the western kerbside lane of Wo Mun Street from its junction with Luen On Street to a point about 25 metres north of the same junction;
- (c) the northern kerbside lane of Luen On Street from its junction with Wo Mun Street to a point about 20 metres east of the same junction;
- (d) the eastern kerbside lane of Wo Mun Street from its junction with Luen On Street to a point about 42 metres north of the same junction; and
- (e) the southern kerbside lane of Luen On Street from a point about 10 metres west of its junction with Luen Wo Road to a point about 73 metres west of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road section will be rescinded.
